## A Brief History Of Waterfront Hotel Bar

**On** a Belgian Block road in Baltimore's Fells Point neighborhood sits Waterfront Hotel. Built as a private residence for Thomas Long, the lot was leased from Ann Giles, wife of Edward Fell, in 1771.

Thomas' brother, Robert Long, built the very first brick home in the City of Baltimore at 812 S. Ann Street near George Street (now Thames). The same bricks were used for both houses, so it can be reasonably assumed that Waterfront Hotel is the second oldest brick building in the City of Baltimore. The bricks used were glazed headers rarely found in structures, and can still be seen.

Thomas Long passed away in 1781 (ten years later), and the property was sold to merchant, John Kirwan, who then sold it in 1791 to Cumberland Dugan – an Irish immigrant from Londonderry, who converted the building to a hotel during the Civil War period (1861-65). Dugan is known to have welcomed his guests by placing an open clam on their pillow. Edgar Allen Poe was also a frequent guest of the hotel & its bar.

Dugan's son Frederick J. Dugan, a lawyer, would eventually inherit the property and pass it on to his son Pierre C. Dugan – who also founded the oldest real estate firm in Baltimore.

In 1948 the building was bought by Mr. James Dembowski, a member of the Maryland Legislature, who purchased the building as a hotel and tavern. The building was discontinued as a hotel in 1955, but remains in use as a tavern to this day .

In 2022, local restaurateurs led by Atlas Restaurant Group purchased Waterfront Hotel and continue to operate Waterfront Hotel as a tavern bar hosting a wide selection of live music, seven days a week.
